Organizing Committee Meeting - EGLE 2014, June 11th

Report

The meeting was held at the EEEI's office from 15:30 to 17:30.

Present: A. Nuée and P-L. Heslout.

Videoconferencing: Ph. Jacquemin, N. Keijser, J. Riedel, R. Orellana and Beatriz Gil.

Excused: B. Deshayes, B. Turner.

In the introduction, Alain Nuée quickly recalls the objectives and procedures of the Organizing Committee.

According to the agenda, are then discussed the following points:

1- Potential Applications:

R. Orellana presents the following applications:

- ➔ Working Groups: Misters Eduardo Martin and Alberto Freire Rodriguez.
- ➔ Propose them the assignment in one of the four groups.
- ➔ Jury : a Spanish Magistrate.
- ➔ Data Study group: Mrs. Gil, lawyer.
- ➔ J. Riedel proposes to contact B. Turner (excused) to organize the working group 3 to be operational after the EGLE's launching meeting in Brussels the 9th of July.
- ➔ Working group 4: this day, 5 participants only.
- ➔ Mr. Nuée suggests identifying a French expert close the court of Versailles. And one British personality (composition required 3 experts and 1 lawyer).

2- Objectives, organization et functioning of the data study group:

➔ As reminder, Mr. Vigneau said he would be absent to the meetings of 14/07/09 in Brussels and of 05/15 in Roma, but in spite of his absence will strive to contribute to the work of this group.

➔ Databank: Mr. Nuée proposed three documents to add.

- The goal for each member of the group is to collect as many documents on the expertise and comparative law in Europe and to submit to the Organization, which then communicates workgroups Committee.
- A. Nuée recalls that the CEPEJ questionnaire, and the work of Mrs. Gar Yein Ng correspond to a pre-view approach seems a lot more work but a long-term horizon. As such, they constitute a time ambient lighting very partial.
- The CEN 405: standard accreditation to corporate practitioner expertise services.

This is a draft standard standardization: the proceedings of the international committee consisting of its development will only succeed in March 2015 in Athens.

R. Orellana is part of this committee. It will ask the president to be allowed to broadcast the draft in the state in text analysis group.

- The text analysis group is autonomous in its mission and must provide the texts and issues for working groups as "food for thought".

As a starting point, the issues before the Conference of Brussels Eurexpertise project.

These issues must be complemented by new ways of thinking.

- That's why; the Organizing Committee must provide work areas 5-8 questions per group oriented on the theme of each group.
Worksheets by country Eurexpertise project will be disseminated to all members for their comments and additions.

In conclusion, A. Flock asked about the possibility that in addition to their proposals to the plenary, each working group has the ultimate goal of drafting a "law" that could be integrated into a law common to all the expertise.

3- Jury:

The Organizing Committee shall estimate the workload of judges and specify its agenda ahead of the contacts needed to be.
