Funding.

I am present at this meeting as the Promoter of the EGLE project, which means mainly as "financer".

Please remember that the EEEI relies mainly on volunteers.

The budget of the EGLE project is €366,000.

The contribution of the DG Justice European Commission is €290,000.

Main budget items:

- staff (Maya and Paul-Louis, half time): €82 000,
- trips/travels: €114 000,
- organization: €140 000
 - translation,
 - interpreting,
 - meetings,
 - ...

For each meeting of the Organizing Committee (OC) and the Working Groups (WG), and for the Plenary Conference of 6 May 2015, the EEEI will fund:

- translations,
- interpreters,
- travel and accommodation
- catering.

Funding policy.

Please ask your institutions, bars, experts associations, courts (when possible) to support travel and accommodation.

When this is not possible, EEEI can support (indicative and average values):

- travel: €390,
- accommodation: €125 per night,
- meal: €25.

The EGLE budget is built on the hypothesis of funding 2 out of 3 people.

Meetings of the Working Groups.

We need each Group to organize the remaining three scheduled meetings in a large city in order to simplify travels, reduce costs (try to avoid accommodation for the nights before and after the meeting).

CEPEJ proposed EEEI to become observer member of the Quality of Justice Group (GT-QUAL). EEEI accepted.

So we must expand its audience and first of all the number of institutional members; today there are 42 (Appeal Courts, Bars, Associations of experts, Universities) and there are 30 institutions more which work with EEEI.
